Willka Tika Day 1

FRI AUG 20

AM: Program begins with a group transfer at 11:30 a.m. from the Cusco airport to **Willka T'ika**, a beautiful 75-minute drive through the spectacular Andean mountain scenery to the Sacred Valley town of Urubamba.

PM: 1:00 pm Lunch at Willka Tika. Welcome group orientation with Angie and Leah, tour guide and the Willka T'ika Quechua staff; staff will assist guests to schedule appointments for any desired spa services. Settle into your room and explore.

5:00 PM Travel Unwind Yoga

6:30 pm: Group Welcome Dinner. (L.D)

Fire Ceremony Day 2

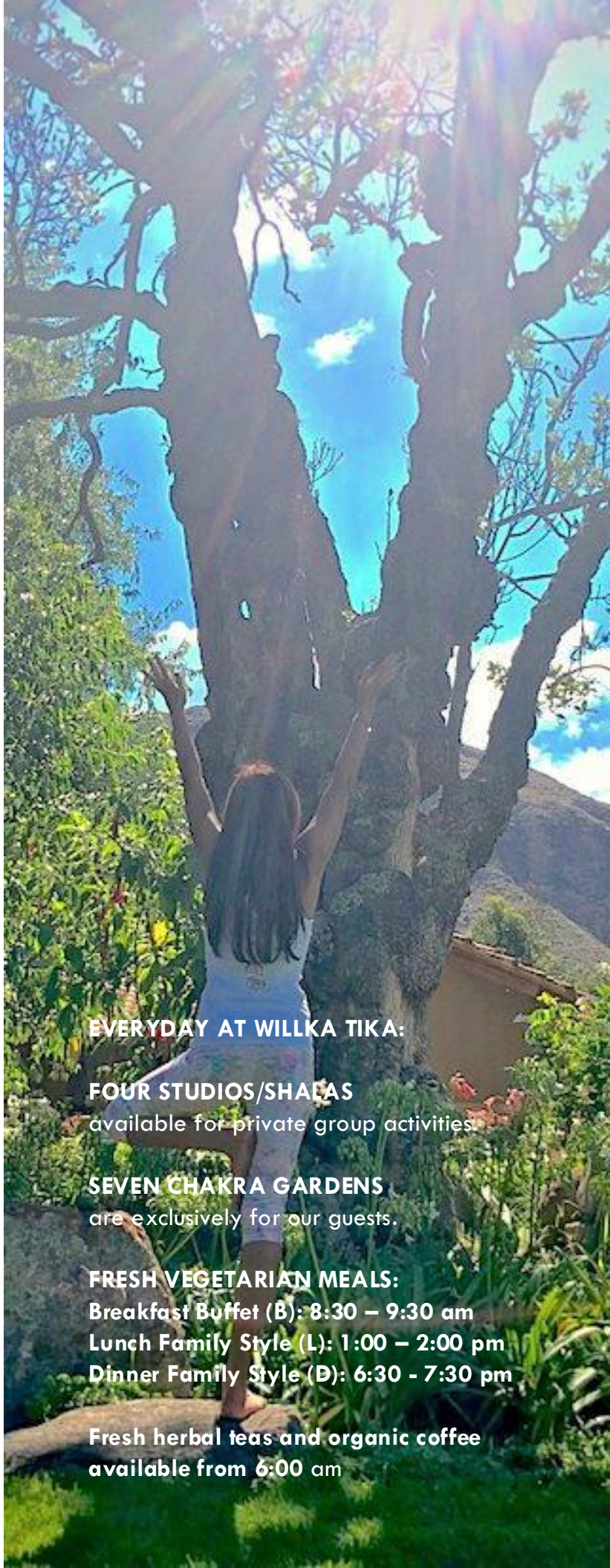
SAT AUG 21

Yoga at 7:30 am

AM: This day is dedicated to *Pachamama*, Mother Earth. Relax in the splendors of nature and enjoy a tour of the Seven Chakra Gardens. Optional guided walk is offered through the nearby *Rumichaka* farming neighborhood where Quechua campesinos live. Visit our onsite WTCF Store and Q'eros artisans.

1:00 pm Lunch.

PM: After lunch, meet our *pakko*, a very special Q'ero healer, visiting from the high Andes. Participate in cocoa leaf blessings and at 5 p.m. sacred *Despacho* ceremony. After dinner, our *pakko* invites guests to an authentic and transformative Andean fire ceremony to honor *Pachamama*, yourself and your loved ones. The ceremony will remind us to focus our intention for this journey and serves as a wonderful preparation of mind, body and spirit for the pilgrimage to Machu Picchu. (B.L.D)

Ollantaytampu & Maras Day 3

SUN AUG 22

7:30 am Yoga

AM: Visit the ceremonial site of **Ollantaytambo** and explore its famous Sun Temple with our guide. Visit the quaint picturesque town with cobblestone streets and its colorful local market.

PM: Picnic Lunch provided. After lunch, group transfer is offered to the nearby ancient **Maras Salt Flats** that are still actively mined to the present day. Enjoy a lovely downhill guided hike back to Willka T'ika with breathtaking valley views.

Pisac & School Visit Day 4

MON AUG 23

7:30 am Yoga

AM:

A day of *Ayni*, or reciprocity. Drive through the Sacred Valley to a Quechua mountain school supported by the non-profit [Willka T'ika Children's Fund](#). Since 1995, Willka T'ika has supported isolated mountain communities where few tourists visit. In an *ayni* exchange, the group will offer an interactive activity for the Quechua children. The warmth and heart-warming joy of the children and their openness in bringing guests into their daily lives are moments not easily forgotten. Enjoy a picnic bag lunch.

PM: Continue with your guide to the spectacular ruins of **Pisac**. Overlooking impressive Incan terraces, the group can enjoy a hike through the ruins. Meditate as a group or walk in silent reflection. Return to the main square of Pisac by bus (or hike!) and visit the colorful market filled with woven goods, jewelry, wall hangings and hand-painted beadwork. Enjoy a café in the market square where you can observe colorfully dressed campesinos. Pisac is a photographer's dream. Return to Willka T'ika with time for a late afternoon garden yoga session before dinner **(TBD)**. (B.L.D)

Machu Picchu Day 5

TUES AUG 24

AM: Early breakfast. Morning tourist train to *Aguas Calientes*, the gateway to the majestic terraces of Machu Picchu. Enjoy an enlightening tour of the ancient “City of Light” with your guide, taking photographs along the way as you enjoy the magnificent views.

PM: Lunch on own, following as your tour guide arranges.

6:30 p.m. Meet outside your hotel. Willka T’ika invites you to a fabulous celebratory dinner in one of the finer restaurants in *Aguas Calientes*. (B.D)

Machu Picchu Day 6

WED AUG 25

AM: Second day visit to Machu Picchu with option to climb **Huayna Picchu Peak** with your tour guide. Return back to the ruins for another vista of the Incan splendor. Take bus back down to *Aguas Calientes* with time for a stop at a local café to enjoy a midday treat in town.

PM: Depart on a later afternoon train back to Ollantaytambo, and transfer to Willka T’ika in time for a late light dinner. (B.D)

THURS AUG 26

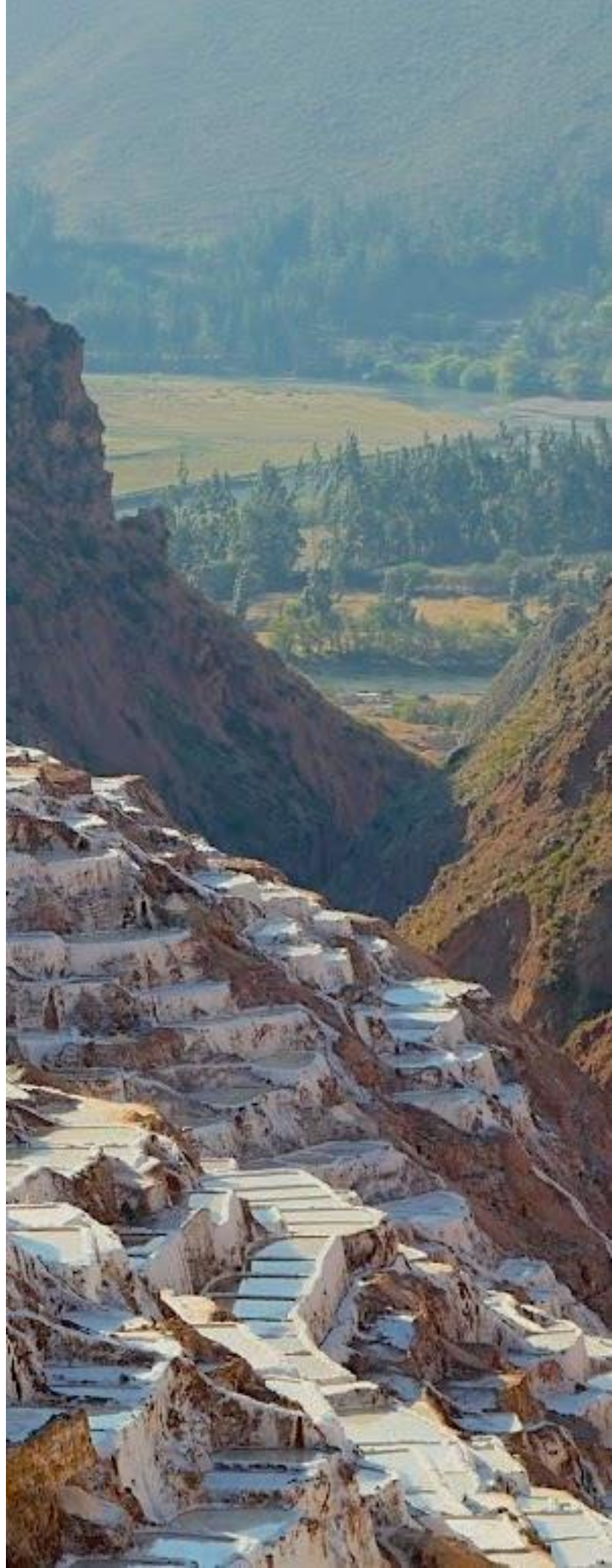
7:30 am Yoga

Guided morning hike to the town of **Urubamba** through farming neighborhoods, and visit a typical, lively Peruvian market, a wonderful alpaca factory, and the famous Seminario ceramics shop. Return via motor taxi.

6:30 pm: Farewell dinner with a lively Andean Classical musical performance, where guests can dance from 7:30-9:00. (B.L.D).





Cusco Day 8

FRI AUG 27

7:30 am Yoga

AM: After breakfast, a group transfer departs Willka T'ika. Continue on to Cusco city. Depart with your guide to the awesome giant stones of **Saksaywaman** overlooking the city of Cusco. Enjoy a picnic lunch and hike around the vast Incan site with a guided tour. Angie and Leah will lead you through a guided yoga practice at the site.

PM: After Lunch, check into your Cusco Hotel conveniently located near the Main Square, and take an afternoon guided walk through the cobblestone streets of San Blas. Your professional guide will point out fascinating Incan stonework en route. Explore the **Korikancha Temple**, the holiest site during Incan times.

6:30 pm: Meet in hotel lobby. Willka T'ika invites the group for a final group dinner at wonderful local restaurant which caters to various dietary preferences. (B.L.D)

Departure Day 9

SAT AUG 28

AM: Breakfast at the Cusco Hotel, followed by Check-Out. Independently arrange with the hotel for your departing transfer to the Cusco airport, to connect to Lima, and your outbound flight home. PACKING ESSENTIALS

Our yoga studios are fully equipped with mats, blocks, straps, some bolsters as well as heavy wool & cotton folded blankets that can serve as bolsters and pillows, so no need to bring yoga equipment.

DINING

Gourmet organic vegetarian meals and fresh teas are served daily, using high-protein Andean grains and legumes, as well as organic, freshly harvested vegetables and salads grown on-site. We welcome vegan, gluten-free, and special dietary requests. Willka T'ika proudly offers a 100% hormone-free and chemical-free gourmet vegetarian hotel kitchen in Peru's Sacred Valley. Our gardens are strictly organic. Filtered water is available 24/7 in dining room, and bottled water is available for purchase.

SIMPLE FOR THE GROUP LEADER

Once in Peru, Willka T'ika staff will help ensure that all pre-trip arrangements go as smoothly as possible. Upon arrival at Willka T'ika, the Guide and Guest Service Staff will confirm times for the leader's group program. Schedule of activities may be flexible to suit leader needs. The Guide is included on the first day at Willka T'ika, and all days with scheduled outings.



LOGISTICS AND PAYMENT

Willka T'ika was originally conceived and is lovingly maintained as an exclusive wellness retreat center. It is open only to registered guests. For additional detailed info for your stay & journey to Peru, see our FAQs [here](#).

Guest Reservation: A nonrefundable \$750/person confirms your retreat dates, payable to the group leader, together with a completed online registration liability waiver [here](#). Final balance is due to your group leader before 60 days prior to the retreat.

Arrival/Departure: Program services begin with a complimentary group transfer from the Cusco airport to Willka T'ika on Day 1 offered at 11:30 a.m., and ends with one group complimentary transfer from Willka T'ika to Cusco on Day 8. Participants arriving at a different time on Day 1 may arrange a private transfer with Willka T'ika, payable in advance. Departing transfers to the Cusco Airport on Day 10 are arranged independently by guests with the Cusco Hotel.

Cost does not include:

- * International roundtrip flight to Cusco via Lima
- * A la carte added group ceremonies or services
- * Separate airport transfers and hotel bookings outside of program
- * Tips, sundries, alcoholic and bottled beverages, laundry and individual spa services
